There is no weight allowance. Weigh in uniform is singlet, no socks or shoes. You will not be allowed to strip down to underclothes and you will not be allowed to leave the weigh in room to run. ## ★ USS YORKTOWN CV-10



***The USS YORKTOWN (CV-10) was the tenth aircraft carrier to serve in the United States Navy.***

Under construction as BON HOMME RICHARD, this new Essex-class carrier was renamed YORKTOWN in honor of YORKTOWN (CV-5), sunk at the epic Battle of Midway (June 1942). Built in an amazing 16½ months at Newport News, Virginia, YORKTOWN was commissioned on April 15, 1943, and participated significantly in the Pacific Offensive began in late 1943 and ended with the defeat of Japan in 1945. YORKTOWN received Presidential Unit Citation, and earned 11 battle stars for service in World War II. Much Academy Award-winning (1944) documentary "The Fighting Lady" was filmed aboard YORKTOWN.

In the 1950's, Yorktown was modified with the addition of an angled deck to better operate jet aircraft in her role as an attack carrier (CVA). In 1958, YORKTOWN was designated anti-submarine aircraft carrier (CVS), and would later earn 5 battle stars for service of Vietnam (1965-1968). The ship also recovered the Apollo 8 astronauts and capsule (December 1968). YORKTOWN was decommissioned in 1970 and placed in reserve; in 1975, was towed from Bayonne, NJ to Charleston to become the centerpiece of Patriots Point Naval and Maritime Museum.
